Process

Use of a radiation detector is required to do a detailed search of contents of building, container, vehicle, etc.

With the RAD-D-W access is not required, only proximity.

If the inspector does not have the **RAD-D-W** he/she must:

- 1. Must file and get authorization to enter and search the area, container, building, or vehicle.
- 2. Find the owner to gain access or break the locks.
- 3. Get one or more co-workers to help as a witness, or for security, and for technical expertise.

Optional: The highly sensitive Neutron Detector gives warning and confirmation that fissionable materials are present.
